TRAVELLING TO THE CENTRE

As you will appreciate it would be extremely difficult for us to include all the information you may need to plan your journey as we have visitors from all over. We hope the details below will be of some help.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT:

If travelling by Public Transport please note the following:

Closest train station if cycling: Chelsfield or Knockholt
Most frequent trains from London to: Orpington
Buses to the Centre from Orpington: R5/R10 (Timetables available)

The stop you need is The Blacksmith's Arms, then you walk down New Barn Lane to the centre.

Buses from Bromley South: 246 (Timetables available)
Alternative station: Oxted
Bus from Oxted: 594 (Timetables available)

The stop you need is at the TOP of Westerham Hill, then walk down (about two miles)– there is a garden centre seen opposite The SHAMPAN AT THE SPINNING WHEEL, which is set back from the main road. Immediately take the left-hand fork (Buckhurst Road) which goes to the left of the Shampan restaurant. After one mile Buckhurst Road becomes New Barn Lane (continue past Berry's Green Road unless you are a coach and need to turn here) and the Centre is a further 300m on the left.

Other Site Access

If driving, visitors should use mini-buses or car-share wherever possible, as car-parking facilities are limited. Coaches are not able to gain access to the centre.

Directions given for cars and mini buses only (for coach access, see below)

M25 southbound from Dartford Tunnel

- Leave the M25 at Junction 4, following the A21 (Bromley).
- At the third roundabout (Bristol St. Motors on left) take the first exit (signed 'Cudham 2.5 miles')
- At the Blacksmiths Arms pub, turn right into New Barn Lane. Cudham Environmental Activities Centre is one mile along on the right.

From M25 anti-clockwise

- Leave M25 at Junction 6, following the A25 to Westerham.
- At Westerham Marketplace follow the A233 (signed 'Biggin Hill').
- This takes you back over the M25 and up Westerham Hill (steep) to a garden centre seen on the left, but **turn RIGHT at The SHAMPAN AT THE SPINNING WHEEL**, which is set back from the main road. Immediately take the left-hand fork (Buckhurst Road) which goes to the left of the Shampan restaurant.
- After one mile Buckhurst Road becomes New Barn Lane (continue past Berry's Green Road unless you are a coach and need to turn here) and the Centre is a further 300m on the left.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Because of the narrow access road, **coaches cannot drive down New Barn Lane or onto the grounds** and coach companies should be advised to contact the Centre for directions.

Important information for coaches

Coaches must approach the Centre via **A233** (Biggin Hill main road) and **Buckhurst Lane** and **must stop and turn round at the junction of Berry's Green Road** and New Barn Lane to go back towards Biggin Hill/Westerham.

N.B. All other routes are too narrow for coaches
